Directions for Use: Use in bait stations only.

Rats and Mice:

Place enough bait in a bait station to present an uninterrupted supply of Ditrac Blox to the rodent population. Bait stations should be loaded as determined by bait station capacity or population density.

Initial baiting should be conducted for at least 10 days before baiting intensity is reduced or increased. Bait stations should be placed at intervals of no more than 100 metres and preferably at 50 metre intervals. Appropriate warning signage should be displayed when baiting on or near public land.
